Question and Answer – Sept 2020

**Below is a list of questions that were submitted during the HM&AR 9/24/20 presentation. The questions and answers have been sorted by topic.

Pregnancy Related Services:

Q1. During remote learning times or for families choosing virtual learning, if teachers of record continue working with students, instead of students being assigned a CEHI teacher, what should be the frequency of interaction between the student and a CEHI teacher or PRS team member? For example, does the student need to continue to receive 4 hours of CEHI to satisfy the PRS requirement, in addition to multiple zoom sessions with teachers of record daily? What if the student does not attend Zoom meetings with a CEHI teacher during the week? Would their PRS coding need to be removed?

A1. If the PRS student is receiving full time virtual instruction and the district is not providing in-home CEHI, the student does not need to receive 4 hours of CEHI services. Campuses, however, must ensure to keep the PRS indicator on until the allowable six weeks (or extended with doctor's note) is over. PRS i
