Pregnancy Related Services:

Q1. During remote learning times or f or families choosing virtual learning, if t eachers of record continue working with students, instead of st udents being assigned a CEHI teacher, what should be the frequency of int eraction between the student and a CEHI teacher or PRS t eam member? For exam ple, does the student need to continue to receive 4 hours of C EHI to satisfy the PRS r equirement, in addition to multiple zoom s with teachers of r ecord daily? What if t he student does not at tend Zoom m eetings with a CEHI teacher during the week? Would their PRS c oding need to be removed?

A1. If the PRS student is receiving full time virtual instruction and the district is not providing inhome CEHI, the student does not need to receive 4 hours of CEHI services. Campuses, however, must ensure to keep the PRS indicator on until the allowable six weeks (or extended with doctor's note) is over. PRS i
