<b>NEXT STEPS:</b>	<b>Share with high school junior-level students and their parents</b>

Senate Bill 175, passed by the 81<sup>st</sup> Texas Legislature, allows The University of Texas at Austin to limit automatic admission to 75 percent of the university's enrollment capacity designated for first-time resident undergraduate students.

The university has determined that it will automatically admit all eligible summer/fall 2021 and spring 2022 freshman applicants who rank within the **top 6%** of their high school graduating classes, with remaining spaces to be filled. This information should be shared with their high school junior level students and their parents.
