The Texas Education Agency (TEA) is committed to supporting local educational agencies (LEAs) in their efforts to improve the safety and security of school facilities for staff, students, and visitors. This To the Administrator Addressed serves as a reminder for LEAs to apply for the 2022-2025 School Safety Standards Formula Grant and to inform them about the upcoming webinar on the 19 TAC Chapter 61, I Facilities, §61.1031, School

Safety Standards.

TEA will be hosting a webinar regarding the School Safety Standards, the <a href="2022-2025 School Safety">2022-2025 School Safety</a> School Safety Standards and Facilities Security Grant launching later this fall.

On January 5, 2023, TEA announced the 2022-2025 School Safety Standards formula grant intended to help districts meet the School Safety Standards. To date, 1,060 LEAs have applied for the School Safety Standards Formula Grant, and 153 LEAs remain eligible to apply. LEAs that have applied do not need to take any additional action at this time. All other LEAs are highly encouraged to take advantage of this funding opportunity to ensure their district has the funding to help meet the School Safety Standards.
